ART WORLD PHENOMENON THOMAS ARVID JOINS FIFTH ANNUAL SAN DIEGO BAY WINE & FOOD FESTIVAL AS "CELEBRITY ARTIST"

In addition to the special seating at the AIWF Luncheon, Festival attendees can rub elbows with the artist during the Silver Oak Wine Dinner at Fleming's on November 13, the Festival's Reserve Tasting on November 14, at the Grand Event on November 15, and at his gallery appearance at Michael J. Wolf Fine Art also on November 15th.
